**Essential Job Duties:**

Mike’s AeroClassics, Inc. is seeking an aircraft mechanic to support the maintenance and preservation of high-value and extreme-use aircraft. In this role, you will be expected to:

- conduct maintenance for periodic inspections, such as opening/closing panels, performing oil and tire changes, and lubricating flight controls;
- repair or remove/replace fabric covering from flight control surfaces & fuselages;
- utilize latest maintenance manuals to inspect, measure and troubleshoot problems, and to identify parts needed for repair or replacement;
- properly document repairs in appropriate aircraft logs per FAA regulations;
- follow specific directions;
- perform other duties as assigned.

These responsibilities will require that you 1) provide a safe, reliable, airworthy aircraft in support of our customers’ needs, 2) accomplish assigned work effectively and efficiently, 3) complete paperwork promptly and properly after service completion, and 4) maintain a clean and safe working environment while practicing safety for yourself and others.

**Required education and qualifications:**

- 2-3 years’ experience maintaining General Aviation aircraft and engines;
  - Special consideration will be given to:
    - A&P trainees who have made significant progress towards earning their A&P certification, and

- A&P students who are currently enrolled in an FAA-certificated A&P program, and who have demonstrated an exceptional record of academic achievement.

- Experience in the use of maintenance reference materials including Manufacturer's Maintenance Manuals, Structural Repair Manuals, Illustrated Parts Catalogs, Component Manuals, etc;
- Experience using electronic maintenance tracking programs;
- Strong computer skills, specifically in MS Office, etc.;
- Valid driver's license and proof of auto liability insurance;
- Personal tools specific to aircraft maintenance. The company will provide specialized equipment for maintenance.

**Additional job requirements:**

- Able to set and execute a flexible work schedule.
- Able to work indoors and outdoors.
- Frequent physical activity including bending, reaching with hands and arms, pushing small aircraft, lifting up to 50 pounds, climbing ladders and working at heights, stooping, kneeling, balancing and crouching.
- Possible travel to other airports to perform maintenance.
